Candidate Submission & Voting Procedures
December 15th, 2002

1. Selection Criteria

- a. Must be a member or past member of the OSSA.**
- b. Does not need to be an active shooter.**
- c. Must be or have been in the past an active participant in the OSSA as a State or Club Officer or a volunteer in the management/administration of NSSA Tournaments such as Shoot Manager, registration, cashiering, score board recorder, food preparation, club maintenance, etc.**
- d. Must have a reputation for service to the OSSA and known by most Skeet Shooters who have shot for at least 5 years.**
- e. Only one (1) J. A. Durham award winner can be selected and inducted in any one year.**

2. Voting Procedures by OSSA Board of Directors

- a. The Durham Memorial candidate information sheets shall be received by the OSSA President.**
- b. The OSSA President will place the names on a written ballot in the order in which they were received (if there is more than one sheet submitted) and the ballots will be distributed at the OSSA spring meeting where the nominees will be discussed prior to the vote by OSSA Officers and Directors.**
